## LETTER EXTRACT

Date: 18/05/1803

Edinburgh

Addressed: M. Tussaud, Boulevard du Temple, No.20, Cabinet de Curtius, Paris.

I hope that this will find you all in good health like us, we are all very well. I told you that we left London on the 27th April and arrived in Edinburgh on the 10th May in good health and good company. We had 36 breaks and dozens of confident people were ill through the bad weather. The sea was terribly rough. We saw three storms which lasted three days and everybody had to go below. The boat rolled in a terrifying manner and the Captain who had made this voyage a hundred times had never seen one like it.

M.Nini was not afraid. He made friends with the captain and with everybody. The captain wished that he had a child like him. He said that he was one of the best Sailors and he wanted to train Nini to be a sailor and said he would be a tribute to France.

We are in a very lovely little town from which we can see the snow covered mountains. I still have a bad head as though I am still on board the boat.

Nini and I embrace you with all our hearts a thousand times. I am for life your wife.

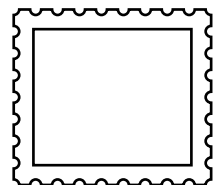
