Rank Marie's challenges from 1-8 in the space provide.

Marie was a young woman in the eighteenth century	Her father was killed in the Seven Years' War just two months before she was born

She had to leave her youngest son behind when she travelled to Great Britain	She was in an unhappy marriage with her husband, François Tussaud
